Steps to Get Started

Take the Online Tutorial

Available 24/7, Bridges selfpaced tutorials make it easy to get started using Choices Explorer right away. Go to www.bridges.ca/tutorials.

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1. Go to www.bridges.ca

Educators

- and sign in to the **Educator** section.
- 2. Click **Create a New Professional Account** and enter the required information, including your Site ID, Password and the Professional Account Access Key or the Administrator Code found in your Welcome Letter.

Your professional account will give you access to Choices Explorer's Professional tools. When signed in to your professional account, all your work will be automatically saved.

Log on Students

- 1. Go to **www.bridges.ca** and click **Create a New Portfolio** in the Students section.
- 2. Enter your required information, including your Site ID and Password. Whenever you work within your portfolio, all work and assessment results will be automatically saved.

Jump In Without a Portfolio

- 1. Go to www.bridges.ca
- 2. Select the Site ID tab and enter your Site ID and Password.
- 3. Click the Choices Explorer badge to jump in and start planning right away.

Administrator Access

To further increase security and control of course plans, passwords, and Professional Account access, Bridges has launched an optional account upgrade – Administrator privileges.

New Choices Explorer customers receive their Site ID, Password, Professional Account Access Key and the Administrator Code by fax or email.

Resubscribing customers can continue to use their previous year's Site ID, Password, and Professional Account Access Key as Bridges does not change these access codes unless requested.
