Steps to Get Started

Educators

- Go to www.bridges.ca and Sign In to the Educators section.
- Click Create a new professional account and enter the required information, including your Site ID, Password and the Professional Account Access Key found in your Welcome Letter.
- 3. Your professional account will give you access to Choices Planner's Professional tools. Select **Choices Planner** or **Professional Tools** from the Your Tools box.

When signed in to your professional account, all your work will be automatically saved.

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Sign In

Students

- Go to www.bridges.ca and click Create a new portfolio in the Student Sign In section.
- Enter your required information, including your Site ID and Password.
- Select Choices Planner from the Your Tools box.

Whenever you work within your portfolio, all work and assessment results will be automatically saved.

Jump In Without a Portfolio

- 1. Go to www.bridges.ca
- 2. Click the **Site ID tab** and enter your Site ID and Password.
- 3. Select **Choices Planner** from the Your Tools box.
- 4. Jump in and start planning right away.
